- Requires live internet access to install and to register (there is no offline registration process). Ping register.ncomputing.com" or 85.214.42.113 to verify that the registration server is available through the local network.
- 2.6.24 kernels built for Ubuntu 8.04 are supported, including (but not limited to) 2.6.24-23-generic and 2.6.24-24-generic
- In addition to the previous Gnome support, support for KDE desktop 3.5 is added to this release (note that KDE 4 is not yet supported)
- Various minor bug fixes are included
- To use audio functions, each new user that's created must be added to the audio group (see the user guide)
- The Linux vSpace admin console is still under development and does not currently implement all features contained in the existing Windows vSpace console
